CHILD OF THE LAMB OR CHILD OF THE GOAT? : PART 1

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Two Atonement Goats, Sin Blamed On Azazel, Watchers Bound In Prison, Rebellious King Saul, Stubborn Apostasy Of The Jews, Prophet Jeremiah In Prison, Stubborn Goats And Yabbuts, Blood Atonement, High Priest And Priests, The Jews' Bloodied Hands

As I point out in the series "The Lamb of God Was a Goat!", as well as in "Judgment Of Azazel: Scapegoat Of The High Priest", part of the sacrifices which were performed on the annual Day of Atonement in ancient Israel, involved the use of two goats without spot or blemish. The first goat, which was slain upon the sacrificial altar, was symbolic of the Sacrifice of Jesus Christ, which would occur some fifteen hundred years later. The second goat, on the other hand, was not killed; but rather it was let go into the wilderness, after a certain rite was performed over its head. Allow me to share with you again some of the verses found in the Book of Leviticus:

"But the goat, on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat, shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make an atonement with him, and to let him go for a scapegoat into the wilderness . . . And when he hath made an end of reconciling the holy place, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar, he shall bring the live goat: And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness: And the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness."

While the first goat was depicted as being void of sin, and was thus slain as an acceptable means of atonement for the sins of the people, their sins were actually transferred to the head of the second goat. In other words, similar to the manner in which we use the word "scapegoat" in our modern day, the blame for the sins of the people, was cast upon the second goat, and not upon the first goat. As you'll discover when you read the aforementioned articles, the reason for this, is that the second goat represents Azazel; who was one of the principle leaders of the Fallen Angels who rebelled against the Lord in Genesis chapter six. It is because he was largely responsible for the wickedness which was wrought by man in the years prior to the Flood, that in the Book of Enoch, we are told that all sin should be ascribed, or attributed, to Azazel:

"And again the Lord said to Raphael: 'Bind Azazel hand and foot, and cast him into the darkness: and make an opening in the desert, which is in Dudael, and cast him therein. And place upon him rough and jagged rocks, and cover him with darkness, and let him abide there for ever, and cover his face that he may not see light. And on the day of the great judgement he shall be cast into the fire. And heal the earth which the angels have corrupted, and proclaim the healing of the earth, that they may heal the plague, and that all the children of men may not perish through all the secret things that the Watchers have disclosed and have taught their sons. And the whole earth has been corrupted through the works that were taught by Azazel: to him ascribe all sin.'"

At this current time, Azazel and all of the other Watchers, that is, the rebellious Angels, have not yet been punished for their crimes against humanity. As I explain in "Judgment of Azazel: Scapegoat of the High Priest", according to Enoch, Peter and Jude, while Satan is still free to roam the Earth at this time, for a great while now, his subordinates have been held in chains of darkness, in a special holding place which is located somewhere deep within the Earth. I discuss this topic of the subterranean prison in more detail in the article entitled "Hell, the Lake of Fire and Universalism". We are given the understanding that Azazel and his demonic hordes will remain there until the Day of the Great White Throne Judgment; at which time they will face the wrath of the Almighty God:

"For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit: By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison; Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water."

1 Peter 3:18-20, KJV

"For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;" 2 Peter 2:4, KJV

"And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day." Jude 1:6, KJV

If there is one characteristic which is quite often used to describe a goat, it is that, similar to a mule or donkey, it can be an extremely stubborn and rebellious creature. We are all familiar with the fact that elderly people are sometimes referred to as "you old goat", because they are stubborn and very set in their ways. How fitting then that Azazel should be depicted by the very same creature, due to his rebellion against the Lord. In the Old Testament, we find quite a few different stories which deal with the sin of rebellion. When the moment arrived for the Prophet Samuel to rebuke old King Saul according to the Word of the Lord, he told the rejected king the following words, which clearly reveal how seriously the Lord views the sins of stubbornness and rebellion:

"For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king." 1 Samuel 15:23, KJV

Upon studying both Biblical and secular history, one quickly discovers that the Jews have always been a very rebellious and stubborn people. Time and time again the Lord has had to rebuke and chastise them for their waywardness. I point this out in a number of different articles, such as in the series "The Fruits of Disobedience", as well as in "The Children of God and Politics". Prior to the Assyrian invasion during the days of the Prophet Isaiah, the northern kingdom of Israel had fallen into such deep apostasy, that the Lord inspired the Prophet to write:

"Why should ye be stricken any more? ye will revolt more and more: the whole head is sick, and the whole heart faint." Isaiah 1:5, KJV

In the previous verse, the word "revolt" is derived from the Hebrew word "carah". Pronounced saw-raw', this word means apostasy, defection, turning aside or withdrawal. While performing Scriptural research for this current article, I made a rather interesting discovery. In a number of places where the word "imagination" is used in the Authorized King James Bible, the actual Hebrew word used is "sheriyruwth". Pronounced sher-ee-rooth', this Hebrew word actually means stubbornness, hardness or firmness. Out of the nine times that it is used in the Old Testament, seven times it is found in the Book of the Prophet Jeremiah. As it is well known by most Bible students, this book contains a message of strong rebuke and impending doom for the land of Judah. Consider the following clear examples which prove this point:

"But they hearkened not, nor inclined their ear, but walked in the counsels and in the imagination of their evil heart, and went backward, and not forward." Jeremiah 7:24, KJV

"But have walked after the imagination of their own heart, and after Baalim, which their fathers taught them:" Jeremiah 9:14, KJV

"Yet they obeyed not, nor inclined their ear, but walked every one in the imagination of their evil heart: therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded them to do; but they did them not." Jeremiah 11:8, KJV

"This evil people, which refuse to hear my words, which walk in the imagination of their heart, and walk after other gods, to serve them, and to worship them, shall even be as this girdle, which is good for nothing." Jeremiah 13:10, KJV

"And ye have done worse than your fathers; for, behold, ye walk every one after the imagination of his evil heart, that they may not hearken unto me:" Jeremiah 16:12, KJV

As I explain in the aforementioned articles, despite the

Lord's serious warning to repent, the Jews of Jerusalem and Judah did not repent of their sins. In fact, rather than repent, they hardened their hearts even further; and on at least two separate occasions, they laid hands upon God's Messenger, Jeremiah, and threw him into prison. Consider the following verses:

"For then the king of Babylon's army besieged Jerusalem: and Jeremiah the prophet was shut up in the court of the prison, which was in the king of Judah's house." Jeremiah 32:2, KJV

"Moreover the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah the second time, while he was yet shut up in the court of the prison, saying," Jeremiah 33:1, KJV

"Wherefore the princes were wroth with Jeremiah, and smote him, and put him in prison in the house of Jonathan the scribe: for they had made that the prison . . . Moreover Jeremiah said unto king Zedekiah, What have I offended against thee, or against thy servants, or against this people, that ye have put me in prison?" Jeremiah 37:15, 18, KJV

"Then took they Jeremiah, and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah the son of Hammelech, that was in the court of the prison: and they let down Jeremiah with cords. And in the dungeon there was no water, but mire: so Jeremiah sunk in the mire." Jeremiah 38:6, KJV

It was because of their continuous stubborn rebellion, and their complete defiance of the Lord's wishes, that finally, after forty years of warning by the Prophet Jeremiah, the Lord allowed Babylonian King Nebuchadnezzar to make three successful invasions of Jerusalem. The final one resulted in the complete destruction of the city around the year 587 BC according to modern historians. Following the Seventy Years of Captivity, during which time a large percentage of the Jerusalemites were held as prisoners in Babylon, the Lord spoke the following through the Prophet Zechariah, in which He referred to the rebellious children of Judah as goats:

"For the idols have spoken vanity, and the diviners have seen a lie, and have told false dreams; they comfort in vain: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because there was no shepherd. Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle." Zechariah 10:2-3, KJV

The purpose for sharing all of the previous information with you, is to make several important points. The first one is this: As I explain in the in-depth series "The Lamb of God Was a Goat!", in the Lord's eyes, there are basically two kinds of people in this world. As Jesus Himself explains in the following story found in Matthew chapter twenty-five, those who hear and obey the Voice of the Lord, are sheep. In other words, they are the Children of the Lamb. On the other hand, those who rebel in stubborn unbelief, are goats; that is, they are the Children of the Goat. In short, either one chooses to follow the Spirit of Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God, in total humility and submission, or else one chooses to stubbornly follow the spirit of Azazel; who as we have seen, is the goat-like subordinate of Satan:

"When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats: And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world . . . Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels . . . And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal." Matthew 25:31-34, 41, 46, KJV

While Azazel and his hordes may currently be restrained in the Lord's prison, his spiritual children are everywhere; and they have been around for a very long time. I refer to these Children of the Goat as "yabbuts". This is because it seems that no matter how much Biblical truth one shares with them, their reply is always the same. They claim to believe in what you say to a certain point, but then, just like a goat, they say "Yeah, but . . ." Just like the spiritual goats that they are, they are always saying "Butt . . . butt . . . butt!" Sadly, the Biblical record clearly indicates that the Jews may be the chief of the children of Azazel; after all, they were the ones who killed the very Lamb of God. Jesus clearly knew that they were not of God; this is why He told them the following in the eighth chapter of the Gospel of John:

"Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it . . . He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God."

John 8:44, 47, KJV

Jesus plainly told them that they were not of God. He told them that they were murderers and of their father the devil. As I point out in such series as "Revelation's Babylon the Great", in Matthew chapter twenty-three, the Lord fully exposed the bloody hands of the Children of the Goat:

"Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! because ye build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulchres of the righteous, And say, If we had been in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the blood of the prophets. Wherefore ye be witnesses unto yourselves, that ye are the children of them which killed the prophets. Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers. Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell? Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and some of them ye shall kill and crucify; and some of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute them from city to city: That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar." Matthew 23:29-35, KJV

The previous verses are directly related to the next point I wish to make with you. This point revolves around the rites which were to be performed with the two goats, by Aaron the High Priest on the Day of Atonement. After sacrificing the first goat, which was innocent of the sins of the people, the High Priest had to do certain things with the blood of the animal, as we see in the following verses:

"And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward; and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times. Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his blood within the vail, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat . . . And he shall go out unto the altar that is before the LORD, and make an atonement for it; and shall take of the blood of the bullock, and of the blood of the goat, and put it upon the horns of the altar round about. And he shall sprinkle of the blood upon it with his finger seven times, and cleanse it, and hallow it from the uncleanness of the children of Israel." Leviticus 16:14-15, 18-19, KJV

This is not the only example where certain things had to be done with the blood of the animal which served as the sin offering. When Aaron and his sons were first consecrated as the priests of the Most High God, a bullock and two rams were used as an atonement for their sins. In that case, we read the following regarding what had to be done with some of the blood from the animals:

"And he brought the bullock for the sin offering: and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the bullock for the sin offering. And he slew it; and Moses took the blood, and put it upon the horns of the altar round about with his finger, and purified the altar, and poured the blood at the bottom of the altar, and sanctified it, to make reconciliation upon it . . . And he brought the ram for the burnt offering: and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the ram. And he killed it; and Moses sprinkled the blood upon the altar round about . . . And he brought the other ram, the ram of consecration: and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the ram. And he slew it; and Moses took of the blood of it, and put it upon the tip of Aaron's right ear, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot. And he brought Aaron's sons, and Moses put of the blood upon the tip of their right ear, and upon the thumbs of their right hands, and upon the great toes of their right feet: and Moses sprinkled the blood upon the altar round about." Leviticus 8:14-15, 18-19, 22-24, KJV

Another example where we see the blood of the sacrificial

animal being used in this way, is in the ritual which was required for the cleansing of lepers. In the fourteenth chapter of the Book of Leviticus, we find the following verse:

"And the priest shall take one he lamb, and offer him for a trespass offering, and the log of oil, and wave them for a wave offering before the LORD: And he shall slay the lamb in the place where he shall kill the sin offering and the burnt offering, in the holy place: for as the sin offering is the priest's, so is the trespass offering: it is most holy: And the priest shall take some of the blood of the trespass offering, and the priest shall take some of the blood of the trespass offering, and the priest shall put it upon the tip of the right ear of him that is to be cleansed, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right

Leviticus 14:12-14, KJV

It is no coincidence that just as the blood of this he lamb, or young ram, was used for the cleansing of the lepers under the Levitical Law, Jesus Christ, the true Lamb of God, also received Power from His Father, to heal lepers. As you can also see from the previous verses, while in the series "The Lamb of God Was a Goat!", I emphasize that a goat was used as the primary means of atonement for sin throughout the Old Testament period, bullocks and rams were also used for the same thing in certain rituals; however, as Paul states, none of these, be they bullocks, rams, or goats, are necessary any longer; for our Lord Jesus Christ has made the Final Sacrifice for sin, once and for all:

"For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins . . . For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified." Hebrews 10:4, 14, KJV

As we saw earlier, having performed the necessary rites with the first innocent goat, Aaron was to lay his hands on the head of the second goat, and then pronounce all of the sins of the people over it. He was to lay blame on the scapegoat before releasing it into the wilderness. As the Apostle Paul makes clear, Aaron was symbolic of the one true High Priest who was to come; that is, Jesus Christ; and in a sense, his sons who performed the priestly services with him, were also symbolic of all of the people of God who not only place their faith in the Blood of the Sacrificial Lamb of God, but who will also someday themselves be priests unto God, under Jesus Christ, our High Priest. Consider the following verses:

"But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man. For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings . . . Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil . . . For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham. Wherefore in all things it

behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people. Hebrews 2:9-10, 14, 16-17, KJV "Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus;" Hebrews 3:1, KJV "Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin." Hebrews 4:14-15, KJV "Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec." Hebrews 6:20, KJV "Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;' Hebrews 8:1, KJV "But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle. not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building;" Hebrews 9:11, KJV "And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.' Revelation 1:6, KJV "And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth." Revelation 5:10, KJV "Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years." Revelation 20:6, KJV Having now explained these things to you, consider the irony of the situation. That lying serpent, Satan, has totally reversed everything in our modern day. In fact, he has been doing it for thousands of years. Just as Aaron, a Child of the Lamb, had to bloody his hands with the innocent blood of the first goat, and then lay his hands upon the head of the second goat, in order to cast the blame for the sins of the people upon it, Satan's false high priest, and priests did, and continue to do the very same thing. As we saw earlier, since the days of the ancient Prophets, the Children of the Goat, Azazel, have been laying their filthy hands upon the Children of the Lamb, just as Aaron laid his hands upon the head of the goat, and they have been killing them ever since.

We have already covered the story of the Prophet Jeremiah;

and we have also seen what Jesus had to say regarding these deceptive murderers who killed the many other Prophets who were sent to them by the Lord. The height of their crimes came almost two thousand years ago when Caiaphas, the false high priest of Satan of that time, along with all of the other Temple priests and Jewish Elders, laid their bloody hands upon the Lord Jesus, and made false accusation against the true High Priest from Heaven; who gave His Blood as a Ransom for many. Consider the following verses:

"And while they abode in Galilee, Jesus said unto them, The Son of man shall be betrayed into the hands of men:" Matthew 17:22, KJV

"But when they sought to lay hands on him, they feared the multitude, because they took him for a prophet." Matthew 21:46, KJV

"Then cometh he to his disciples, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take your rest: behold, the hour is at hand, and the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners . . . And Jesus said unto him, Friend, wherefore art thou come? Then came they, and laid hands on Jesus, and took him." Matthew 26:45, 50, KJV

"For he taught his disciples, and said unto them, The Son of man is delivered into the hands of men, and they shall kill him; and after that he is killed, he shall rise the third day." Mark 9:31, KJV

"And he cometh the third time, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take your rest: it is enough, the hour is come; behold, the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners . . And they laid their hands on him, and took him." Mark 14:41, 46, KJV

"Let these sayings sink down into your ears: for the Son of man shall be delivered into the hands of men." Luke 9:44, KJV

"And the chief priests and the scribes the same hour sought to lay hands on him; and they feared the people: for they perceived that he had spoken this parable against them." Luke 20:19, KJV

"Saying, The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again." Luke 24:7, KJV

"Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God." John 5:18, KJV

"After these things Jesus walked in Galilee: for he would not walk in Jewry, because the Jews sought to kill him." John 7:1, KJV

"Did not Moses give you the law, and yet none of you keepeth the law? Why go ye about to kill me? The people answered and said, Thou hast a devil: who goeth about to kill thee?" John 7:19-20, KJV

"And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill him; for they feared the people . . . When I was daily with you in the temple, ye stretched forth no hands against me: but this is your hour, and the power of darkness." Luke 22:2, 53, KJV

"Then they sought to take him: but no man laid hands on him, because his hour was not yet come . . . And some of them would have taken him; but no man laid hands on him." John 7:30, 44, KJV

"These words spake Jesus in the treasury, as he taught in the temple: and no man laid hands on him; for his hour was not yet come." John 8:20, KJV

"Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain:" Acts 2:23, KJV

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CHILD OF THE LAMB OR CHILD OF THE GOAT? : PART 2

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Washing Of Hands, Pontius Pilate, Cut Off Hands?, Guilt Of The Jews, Passing The Buck, Crafty Perversion Of Christian Doctrine, The Willingness Of Jesus Christ, Ignorance And Accountability, False Ministers Of Light, Persecution Of Children Of The Lamb, Apostasy And Mark Of The Beast, The Lord's Hands Of Blessing And Healing, The Apostles Lay On Hands To Heal, Laying On Of Hands To Receive The Holy Ghost God's Divine Wrath Meted Out And Revelation's Second Harvest

While the hands of the Jewish Elders had been bloodied for many centuries prior to the arrival of Christ, they made every attempt to self-righteously conceal this fact, by boasting of their ability to keep the Mosaic Law. Being as the physical is a manifestation of the spiritual, it should come as no surprise that one way in which these Children of the Goat attempted to conceal their murder of the Children of the Lamb, was through the tradition of the washing of hands. Through this and other acts, they convinced the common people of their goodness and holiness. Consider the following verses: "Why do thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? for they wash not their hands when they eat bread . . . These are the things which defile a man: but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not a man." Matthew 15:2, 20, KJV

"And when they saw some of his disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault. For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash their hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders. And when they come from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, as the washing of cups, and pots, brasen vessels, and of tables. Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands? He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me. Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men." Mark 7:2-7, KJV

We are also told that the men-pleasing Roman procurator, Pontius Pilate, who preferred to be a friend of the Jews, instead of being a friend of God, also tried to rid himself of the guilt of having Jesus' Blood on his hands. This he did, when he bowed to political correctness, and performed the following symbolic act, as he gave Jesus into the hands of the Children of the Goat:

"When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye to it." Matthew 27:24, KJV

As we know, Jesus often spoke in very cryptic language, in order to hide the true meaning of His words from those who were not meant to understand them, or who would not accept the truth of His words anyway. Such is the case with the following words He spoke in Matthew chapter eighteen:

"Wherefore if thy hand or thy foot offend thee, cut them off, and cast them from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life halt or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet to be cast into everlasting fire." Matthew 18:8, KJV

These words have undoubtedly been difficult to understand for many Christians. Is Jesus suggesting that we literally cut off our hands or our feet if we commit sin with them, in order that we might be found worthy of Eternal Life? Is the Lord suggesting that we are to literally follow the precepts of the Mosaic Law, even as the Muslim Arabs do today in our modern world? Based upon everything I have stated thus far, I am of the opinion that this is not the case whatsoever. What the Lord is really stating, is that we should separate ourselves from those who have unclean hands and unwashed feet. In other words, He is referring to those who have not accepted Him as their Saviour; and who thus do not walk down the Path of Life. For a much clearer understanding of how our feet are related to this issue, please refer to the revelatory article "Are You Clean Every Whit?". For the time being, consider the following verse:

"Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you," 2 Corinthians 6:17, KJV

As I point out in other articles such as "Is God A Racist?", and "Revelation's Babylon the Great", try as they may, the unbelieving Jews cannot possibly conceal their bloodied hands, or rid themselves of their guilt, except by one means alone. Through their own pride and evil hearts, they brought this guilt upon themselves, when they foolishly cried out:

". . . His blood be on us, and on our children." Matthew 27:25b, KJV

The only way that these stubborn Children of the Goat will ever be able to cleanse their bloodied hands, is by drawing close to God, and to His Holy Throne of Grace, through their humble acceptance of the Lord Jesus Christ. Only in this way will their hands finally be cleansed, and their hearts purified; for as James wrote:

"Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded. Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up." James 4:7-10, KJV

Sadly, the vast majority of Jews, particularly those in the state of Israel, are not yet prepared to do this. Not only that, but they are still trying to convince the world that their hands are clean; by trying to transfer their guilt to a second party; that is, to the Romans. What is so sad about this fact, is that through their crafty placement of false preachers and teachers in certain Christian churches, these wicked workers of darkness have even begun to convince some naive Christians of this very same thing. It wasn't really the Jews' fault that Christ was crucified, they claim; it was the fault of the Romans. This is a blatant lie, which I will prove in a moment.

It has also come to my attention, that some misguided Christians even go so far as to now claim that we are all responsible for Christ's death. Whether we are Jewish, or a Gentile, or a Roman who lived during the time of Christ, we all carry equal guilt, they say. We all have bloodied hands. They would have us to believe that there is no difference. While it is indeed true that we are all sinners, again, this belief is a blatant distortion of the truth, and it is not supported by the Holy Scriptures. On the other end of the spectrum, we find those who claim that no one carries any guilt for Christ's Crucifixion, because Jesus laid down His life of His own accord. Some of the verses they twist in order to support this false belief are the following: "No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father." John 10:18, KJV

"He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth." Isaiah 53:7, KJV

While it is indeed true that Jesus gave His life willingly for the sins of the world, it is also true that God still had to use a human vehicle in order to accomplish His Divine Purposes. Jesus willingly went to the slaughter in order to atone for the sins of the world, but there still had to be a butcher; and as we saw in part one, that executioner was the weak Roman procurator Pontius Pilate; who was pressured into performing his evil deed, by the Jewish Elders, through mob rule and political correctness; that is, by proving that he, Pilate, was still a friend of Caesar's. While the Jews, and even some misguided Christians, try to now say that we all carry equal guilt for the Crucifixion, please notice very carefully in the following verses, to whom Jesus attributes the greater sin:

"Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? knowest thou not that I have power to crucify thee, and have power to release thee? Jesus answered, Thou couldest have no power at all against me, except it were given thee from above: therefore he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin. And from thenceforth Pilate sought to release him: but the Jews cried out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not Caesar's friend: whosoever maketh himself a king speaketh against Caesar." John 19:10-12, KJV

"If I had not come and spoken unto them, they had not had sin: but now they have no cloke for their sin. He that hateth me hateth my Father also. If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father." John 15:22-24, KJV

"And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved." John 3:19-20, KJV

So as you can plainly see, yes, Jesus did in fact give His life freely, but the jealous Jews chose to forcefully take it from Him, when they first laid their bloodied hands upon Him in the Garden. Later, they delivered Him into the hands of Pilate, in order that He might be crucified; even against Pilate's wishes; and this is why Jesus very clearly states that it is upon the unbelieving Jews, that the greater sin, and the greater guilt, falls. Jesus said "he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin". Do you know why Jesus said this? Do you know why Jesus said that the Jews had no cloak for their sin? Obviously, it is because they had a greater knowledge of the Truth. Not only did they have the Scriptures; not only did they have Moses and the Prophets; but they had seen Him work many miracles before their very eyes; and still they did not believe.

The Children of Darkness, the Children of the Goat, knew exactly what they were doing; yet they did it anyway. God can only hold people accountable for how much Truth they possess. This is why the Apostle Paul also stated regarding his former persecution of the Saints:

"And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry; Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did it ignorantly in unbelief." 1 Timothy 1:12-13, KJV

While Peter tried to excuse the unbelieving Jews in order to win them to Christ in Acts chapter three, when he preached to the Athenians on Mars' Hill, the Apostle Paul boldly asserted that the time of ignorance was past; and that it was now time for all men everywhere to repent, and to accept Christ. Later, in his Epistle to the Corinthians, Paul also said that now is the day of Salvation:

"And now, brethren, I wot that through ignorance ye did it, as did also your rulers. But those things, which God before had shewed by the mouth of all his prophets, that Christ should suffer, he hath so fulfilled. Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;"

Acts 3:17-19, KJV

"And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:" Acts 17:30, KJV

"(For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)" 2 Corinthians 6:2, KJV

Returning for a moment to the Lord's trial, when Pilate tried to do what was right, even being warned by his very own wife, who was it who cried out in protest? John writes "but the Jews cried out". That is Scriptural fact which no one can change. Jesus said that the greater sin is upon the Jews, and we should believe it; no matter what any of these modern false prophets and teachers might try to say. Those who say and teach such things are in great error; and they are false ministers of light; of whom the Apostle Paul told us to be warned;

"For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works."

2 Corinthians 11:13-15, KJV

Not content with having murdered the Prophets of old, with having laid their hands upon the head of John the Baptist, and then with laying their already-bloodied hands on the very High Priest of God, Jesus Christ Himself, the wicked Children of the Goat continued their evil persecution of the innocent Children of the Lamb in the Book of Acts. Time and time again they threatened the Disciples. In some cases, as with James, who was beheaded by Herod, and Stephen, who was stoned to death by the Jewish Elders, they were killed; while at other times, they were dragged before the Jewish Elders, and threatened and beaten, and sometimes thrown into prison; sometimes to be miraculously rescued by the Lord's Angels. Consider the following verses:

"But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake." Luke 21:12, KJV

"And they laid hands on them, and put them in hold unto the next day: for it was now eventide." Acts 4:3, KJV

"And laid their hands on the apostles, and put them in the common prison." Acts 5:18, KJV

"Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth his hands to vex certain of the church." Acts 12:1, KJV

"And when he was come unto us, he took Paul's girdle, and bound his own hands and feet, and said, Thus saith the Holy Ghost, So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man that owneth this girdle, and shall deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles . . . And when the seven days were almost ended, the Jews which were of Asia, when they saw him in the temple, stirred up all the people, and laid hands on him," Acts 21:11, 27, KJV

"And it came to pass, that after three days Paul called the chief of the Jews together: and when they were come together, he said unto them, Men and brethren, though I have committed nothing against the people, or customs of our fathers, yet was I delivered prisoner from Jerusalem into the hands of the Romans." Acts 28:17, KJV

"And through a window in a basket was I let down by the wall, and escaped his hands." 2 Corinthians 11:33, KJV

Moving up to what may be the very near future, we discover that even after the Lord has severely punished the wicked spiritual children of Azazel the scapegoat, for having dared to put their filthy hands upon His children and persecuted them lo these many centuries, they still will not repent of their evil deeds. Notice that the murder of God's lambs is counted among the works of their hands: "And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk: Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts." Revelation 9:20-21, KJV

What I also find quite significant, is that this is directly related to the Mark of the Beast. Because they have already yielded themselves to Satan in their minds, and through the evil works of their hands, could this be why they will also so willingly accept the Mark of the Beast, which many, like myself, believe may be an actual biochip implant which will connect everyone into the worldwide electronic credit system of the Beast? Remember the verse I shared in part one about revolting more and more into total apostasy:

"Why should ye be stricken any more? ye will revolt more and more: the whole head is sick, and the whole heart faint." Isaiah 1:5, KJV

"And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six." Revelation 13:16-18, KJV

"And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years." Revelation 20:4, KJV

While I have thus far shown how the forces of darkness have totally reversed the ancient rites of the high priest, so that now the Children of the Goat lay their hands upon the heads of the Children of the Lamb, in order to blame them for the woes of the world, there is another brighter side to this story as well. In the New Testament, we discover that Jesus laid His hands upon different people in order to bless them; such as in the example of the small children. At other times, it was in order to heal a certain person of a bodily and/or a spiritual affliction. Consider the following verses:

"Then were there brought unto him little children, that he should put his hands on them, and pray: and the disciples rebuked them. But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven. And he laid his hands on them, and departed thence." Matthew 19:13-15, KJV "And they brought young children to him, that he should touch them: and his disciples rebuked those that brought them. But when Jesus saw it, he was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God. Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child, he shall not enter therein. And he took them up in his arms, put his hands upon them, and blessed them." Mark 10:13-16, KJV

"And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them." Luke 24:50, KJV

And besought him greatly, saying, My little daughter lieth at the point of death: I pray thee, come and lay thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live." Mark 5:23, KJV

"And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing him were astonished, saying, From whence hath this man these things? and what wisdom is this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands? . . . And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them." Mark 6:2, 5, KJV

"And he cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto him, and besought him to touch him. And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought. And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking. After that he put his hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly." Mark 8:22-25, KJV

"Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them." Luke 4:40, KJV

"And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God." Luke 13:13, KJV

As the Lord Himself had promised, His followers performed even greater works than Himself, for as Jesus had said, He had to return to the Father. This is also covered in the article "Are the Gifts of the Spirit for Today?". Consider the following verses where we see that, contrary to the Children of the Goat who lay their hands on people in order to commit evil, the Children of the Lamb lay their hands on people in order to do good:

"Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father." John 14:12, KJV "They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover." Mark 16:18, KJV

"And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch." Acts 5:12, KJV

"Long time therefore abode they speaking boldly in the Lord, which gave testimony unto the word of his grace, and granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands." Acts 14:3, KJV

"And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul:" Acts 19:11, KJV

"And it came to pass, that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and of a bloody flux: to whom Paul entered in, and prayed, and laid his hands on him, and healed him." Acts 28:8, KJV

"Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much." James 5:14-16, KJV

In the Book of Acts, after the Holy Spirit had been imparted to the Disciples on the Day of Pentecost, this very same Gift of the Spirit was transferred to others through the act of laying one's hands upon another. When I received the Baptism of the Holy Ghost many years ago, this is precisely how it was done with me. While the following verses show how the Holy Ghost was received through the laying on of the Apostles' hands, please note that this particular request was actually made by evil Simon the Sorcerer; who was soon found out. We never hear of him again after Peter exposes his wicked heart:

"Whom they set before the apostles: and when they had prayed, they laid their hands on them." Acts 6:6, KJV

"Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost. And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost. But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money." Acts 8:17-20, KJV

"As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them. And when they had fasted and prayed, and laid their hands on them, they sent them away. So they, being sent forth by the Holy Ghost, departed unto Seleucia; and from thence they sailed to Cyprus. Acts 13:2-4, KJV "And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied. Acts 19:6, KJV "Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery. 1 Timothy 4:14, KJV "Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands." 2 Timothy 1:6, KJV "Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. Hebrews 6:2, KJV So while God's children are commanded to lay hands upon a person in order to heal and to impart the Holy Ghost, the disobedient and unbelieving children of the world do it in order to hurt and to do wrong. What these foolish Children of the Goat do not realize, is that when they lay their filthy hands upon the Children of the Lamb, they are committing a very grave error, because the Scriptures plainly tell us: "Saying, Touch not mine anointed, and do my prophets no harm." Psalms 105:15, KJV While these foolish people may not realize it now, once their cup of iniquity is full, they are going to fall into the Hands of a wrathful God, and they are not going to like it! As the Apostle Paul wrote in his Epistle to the Hebrews: "It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God . . . For our God is a consuming fire." Hebrews 10:31, 12:29, KJV In the Book of Revelation, after the Harvest of Souls takes place at the end of this current system of man, when Christ returns for His beloved children, we are told that a second harvest will take place. We might refer to this harvest as the Harvest of Wrath. In the fourteenth chapter we find the following verses which describe it: "And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence

of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb . . . And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe. And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs." Revelation 14:9-10, 17-20, KJV

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CHILD OF THE LAMB OR CHILD OF THE GOAT? : PART 3

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Great White Throne Judgment And Lake Of Fire, Laying Hands On Suddenly, In Jesus' Hands, Conclusion, Reading Resources

Of course, when it comes to this act of laying one's hands on somebody, we also know that the final Person to do this will be the Lord Himself; for in the distant future, after the one thousand year Millennium, when the Great White Throne Judgment occurs, we are told that the Lord will do His final house cleaning. He will lay hold on that old serpent called the Devil and Satan, and cast him into the Lake of Fire; along with Azazel and his cohorts, and all of the other incorrigible and unrepentant Children of the Goat:

"And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire." Revelation 20:10-15, KJV

Before concluding this article, let us take a look at one more verse which deals with the laying on of hands. In his first Epistle to his beloved son in the faith, Timothy, the Apostle Paul wrote the following:

"Lay hands suddenly on no man, neither be partaker of other men's sins: keep thyself pure." 1 Timothy 5:22, KJV

It seems that some Christians have erroneously interpreted this verse as a warning from Paul regarding the laying on of hands. They suggest that Paul is saying that just as we can impart spiritual and physical blessings to others, if one is not careful regarding upon whom he lays his hands, this same process can also work in reverse; so that a person may pick up a curse or something evil from that person. I tend to believe that Paul wasn't referring to the spiritual gift of the laying on of hands, but rather to laying our hands upon someone in a moment of anger, as we see occurring with the Children of the Goat. When Paul talks about not partaking of other men's sins, he is not talking about having their sins transferred to us through a laying on of hands, but rather to things like the following from his Epistle to the Ephesians:

"Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another. Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath: Neither give place to the devil. Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth. Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers. And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you." Ephesians 4:25-32, KJV

"I will therefore that men pray every where, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting." 1 Timothy 2:8, KJV

Notice that Paul talks a lot about wrath and evil speaking in the previous verses. He talks about using our hands in a good way, to be a blessing; and not in an evil way, as do the Children of the Goat. When a person lays their hands suddenly on another person, doesn't it involve wrath, anger and evil speaking, exactly as Paul states? So again, I think this may be what Paul really meant by not laying one's hands suddenly upon any man; because that is precisely what the enemies of Christ and His Disciples actually did, and which they continue to do to this very day. They grab the Children of the Lamb, His dear foreign missionaries, in anger, and speak evil of them. They cast them into prison and torture them, and sometimes even kill them. The reports we hear of Christian persecution in some of the communist and Muslim countries are absolutely alarming. As we draw closer to the end, Satan is becoming more and more furious, because he knows that his time is short:

"Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them.

Woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time." Revelation 12:12, KJV

To conclude this article on a positive note, consider the fact that at the end of this life, just like Jesus, our eternal High Priest, who committed His Spirit into the Hands of His Heavenly Father, because He knew that He came from God, and would return to God, we too, the Children of the Lamb, shall commit our spirits into the Hands of the Lord Jesus Christ, because we are His sheep; we are not goats; and He has paid for us with His own Blood on the Cross. Consider the following verses:

"And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost." Luke 23:46, KJV

"Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me." John 8:42, KJV

"Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God;" John 13:3, KJV

"And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand." John 10:28, KJV

"All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out." John 6:37, KJV

"Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, Let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity." 2 Timothy 2:19, KJV

In conclusion, which are you? Are you a Child of the Lamb, or are you a stubborn and rebellious Child of the Goat? If you are not sure, please accept Jesus Christ as your Lord and Saviour today. It's not too late. He stands waiting with outstretched arms. Don't delay; please do it today! You'll be glad you did!
